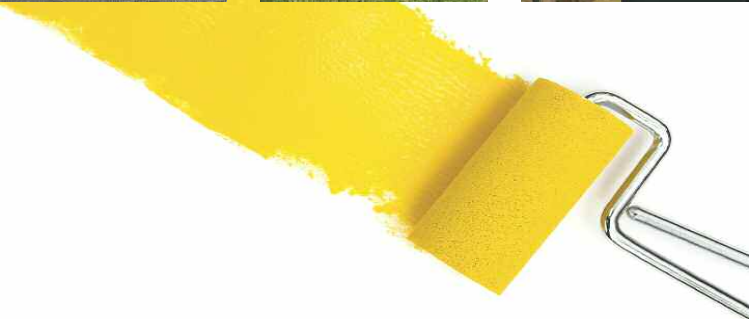

What do we do?

Medra Estate Caretaker

- Our Estate Caretakers work to improve our communities by clearing all unnecessary waste and ensuring all communal areas are kept clean and tidy
- We will also provide a garden maintenance service on behalf of the Handyperson Service

Medra Handyperson

- Our Handypeople can assist vulnerable tenants and those over 55 with maintenance jobs such as gardening or minor improvements around the home
- We are here to help you with those things you may find difficult if you are an older resident or have a disability
- Our Handypeople teams have all been vetted and will be able to show you their identification badge when they knock on your door



Who do we help?

Medra Estate Caretaker

- We help everyone by keeping where you live clean and tidy

Medra Handyperson

- The Handyperson service is for people aged 55+ who have difficulties carrying out small jobs around the house, and for people of any age with a disability



How can we help you?

Medra Estate Caretaker

We keep estates clean and tidy by:

- Regular inspections of estates and play areas
- Clearing up fly tipping
- Removal of graffiti
- Maintaining Sheltered Scheme communal garden areas

We can also offer a gardening service which includes:

- Weeding and pruning
- Grass cutting
- Hedge trimming
- Laying stones or bark
- Painting fences or sheds



Medra Handyerson

These are the kinds of things the Handyerson could help you with. Please call us if your job is not listed and we will do our best to help you:

- Changing light bulbs and tap washers
- Cleaning windows
- Painting and decorating
- Moving furniture within the house
- Putting together flat pack furniture
- Securing carpets
- Securing trailing wires and flexes
- Putting up shelves, bathroom cabinets and other small items of a similar nature
- Taking down and putting up curtains/tracks/blinds
- Small areas of tiling
- Fitting grab rails and handrails



How much will it cost?

When you call the general enquiries line ask for Medra and an estimate will be given before the job is booked in.

We will also be providing training opportunities for people that are not currently in work, so in some cases you'll get two or three people for the price of one!

All trainees will be vetted, carry ID badges, and be wearing a uniform with the Medra logo.
